## Event Duration:

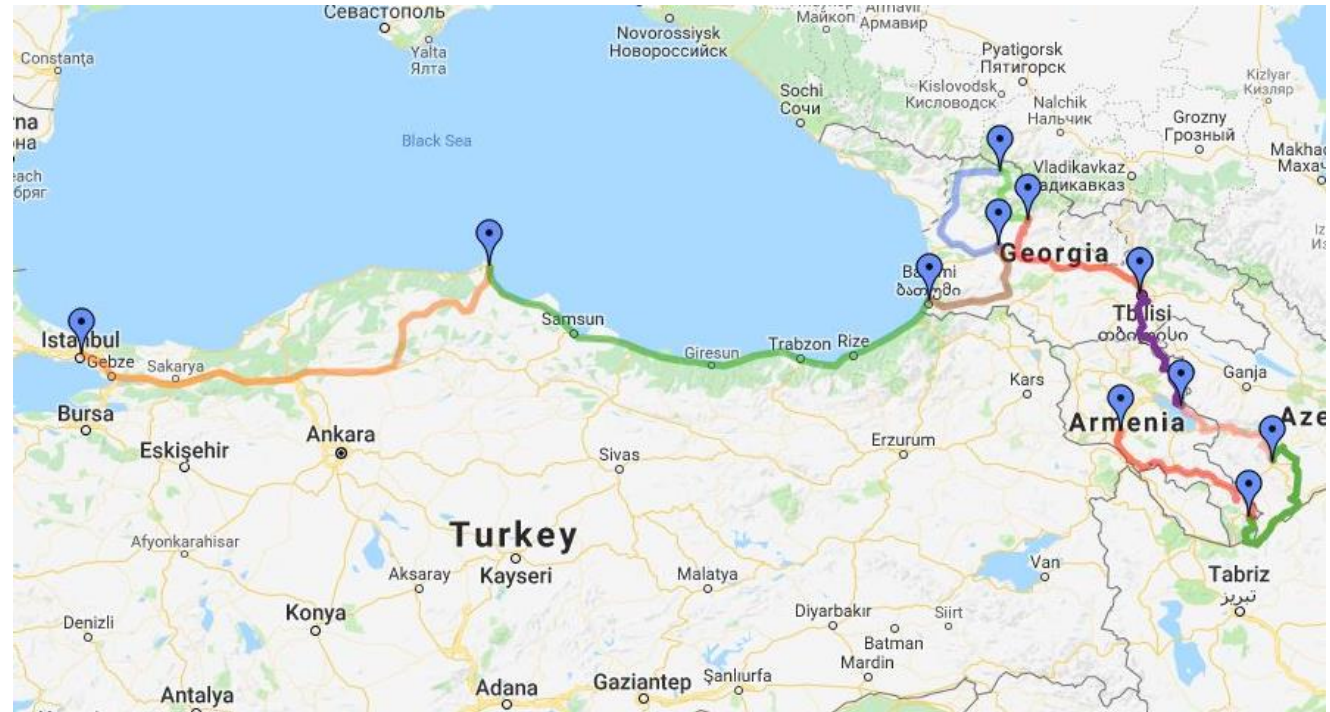
13 – 23 August 2019

## Distance:

4,000 kilometers (2,500 miles)

Once assembled, they embark on a 4,000 km trek across the Caucasus in their vehicles of choice, be it a classic Lada or their brand new Land Rover, finally reaching Yerevan, Armenia after 11 eventful days.
